

Trekking, Trekking, Trekking

We present below the trekking routes we have been organizing in the past. The rhythm of everyday trekking can be modified according to your wishes. All trekking tours are escorted by car, horse or camel.

A detailed offer adjusted to your arrival dates, number of trekking days and other details will be sent to you upon request. All these routes are based on an average of 6 hours trekking each day. During your trekking you will visit nomadic families, do camping, enjoy the nature, flora and fauna.

Trip T1. Trekking in Altai Tavan Bogd and the Mongol Els sand dunes

This trip is a combination of trekking and jeep tours in 2 different parts of the country. Altai Tavan Bogd is the most mountainous part of the while the Mongol Els sand dunes are located at the lowest altitudes of the country. Including transfers of local flights Ulaanbaatar – Ulgii and Altai – Ulaanbaatar, the trip requires a total of 21 days.



Discover the

majestic Altai Mountains and its snow-capped peaks, see the holy peaks of Altai Tavan bogd and its glaciers, and discover the pristine lakes and rivers in western Mongolia!

The area is rich with remains of old traces: petroglyphs, stone men, and burial mounds. You will explore the most isolated region of Mongolia where you can visit nomadic Kazakh families who train and hunt with golden eagles and see how Kazakh women decorate their gers (yurt) with their handmade colorful embroideries.

Further down you will see Mongol Els (Mongolian Sands) – the biggest singing sand dunes with the faraway panorama of the snowcapped Altai Mountains. Mongol Els are the biggest sand dunes of Mongolia. See Lake Ereen - a fresh water lake in the middle of the sand dunes.

All inclusive price per person : USD 2,075 based on a constituted group of 4 persons /1 vehicle/ and 2 joining team members /total 21 days, 8 days trekking in Altai Tavan Bogd, 3 days trekking in Mongol Els sand dunes, local flights Ulaanbaatar – Ulgii, Altai - Ulaanbaatar (see a detailed service description at the end of this document).

Trip T2. Trekking in Naiman Lake and Orkhon Valley



- This is a 5-day trekking trip in Naiman Lake and Orkhon Valley.

Visit nomadic families, stay with nomadic families, discover the mountain lakes of Naiman Nuur, the picturesque valley of Orkhon River and its waterfalls, Tovhon Monastery situated on top of forest mountains, visit Kharhorin - the ancient capital of Chinggis Khan's Empire and the Erdenezuu monastery.

On the way to Ulaanbaatar, you will cross Elsentsarhai, an area presenting a mix of all landscapes: mountains, sands and rivers. Visit also the Hustai National Park and see the wild horses "takhi" – the only truly wild horses remaining on Earth.

Indicative price (Price does not include transfers to Mongolia)

All inclusive price per person : USD 925 based on a constituted group of 4 persons /1 vehicle/ and 2 joining team members /total 10 days (see a detailed service description at the end of this document).

Indicative prices above correspond to the following services:

- 2 nights in hotel (double room basis) in Ulaanbaatar and other nights in tents or gers



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- Exclusive use for the entire duration of the stay of a one 4x4 vehicle, including fuel and lubricants supply, vehicle maintenance and service;
- Support team of 2 guides: an interpreter/cook and a driver/mechanic, including their food and accommodations;
- All transfers in Ulaanbaatar;
- Organization of visits, entertainment/shopping according to your wishes and preferences (museums, monasteries, open market, tours of ger districts, etc.) in Ulaanbaatar;
- Welcome and farewell dinners upon arrival in and prior to departure from Mongolia;
- All food and drinks in the countryside prepared by cook
- Camping/cooking/fishing/riding gear rental (tent, sleeping bag, mattress, pillow, blanket, table and chairs, cookware, saddle, fishing rod and reel, line and 2 fishing hooks);
- Horses, local guide, packhorse, saddle and other equipments
- Local flight tickets
- Fees and taxes for entrance and stay at the national parks, especially protected areas and natural reserves
